The continent contains over 2000 Key Biodiversity Areas, 9 of the planet's 36 biodiversity hotspots, 25% of the world's mammals and the greatest large mammal population on the planet, a fifth of the world's birds, and one sixth of the earth's remaining intact forests.

Maliasili's partners are on the frontline of tackling these most pressing issues.

We select the the best African conservation organizations that care about both people and places, and that put communities at the center of their work by:

- **Strengthening rights** over land and natural resources
- **Providing economic incentives** for conservation efforts
- **Enhancing local decision-making** and management bodies

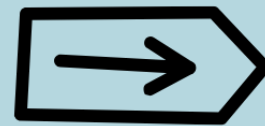

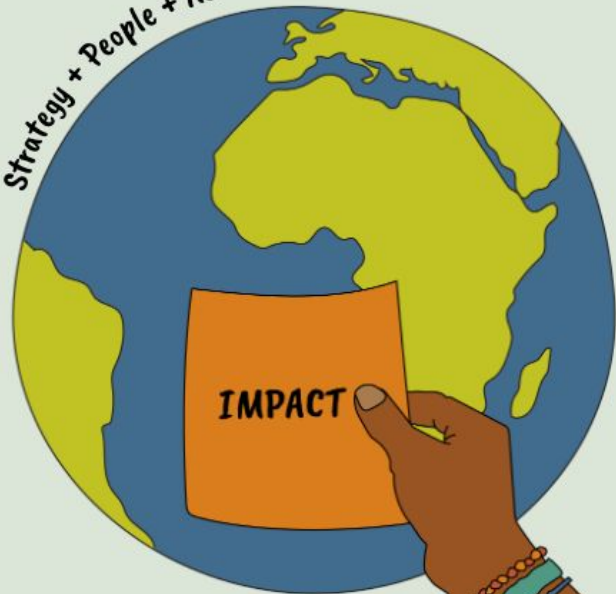

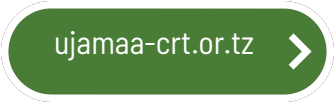

They work with nearly 100 local communities across over 2 million hectares in northern Tanzania, from the borders of the Serengeti to the southern Maasai Steppe.

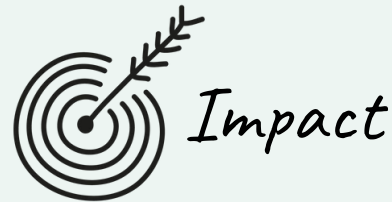

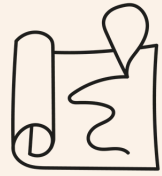
CLAWS partners with people to develop and implement creative solutions to promote human-wildlife coexistence, restore rangelands, and conserve wildlife in northern Botswana.

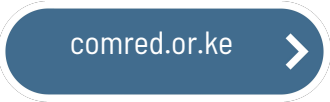




Coastal and Marine Resource Development (COMRED) works to help communities develop practical solutions to better manage their marine environment in coastal Kenya. 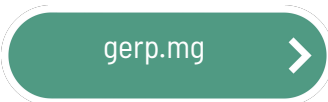

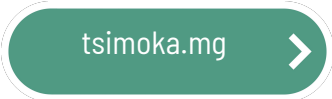

Tsimoka began developing their model in Oronjia in 2017, a protected area they manage in the North of Madagascar. Tsimoka worked closely with local communities to test dynamic agroforestry and ecological restoration techniques, that were successful in improving livelihoods and restoring water and soil quality. They are now scaling up their approach through partnerships to accelerate the restoration of ecological functions and improve the livelihoods of local communities.

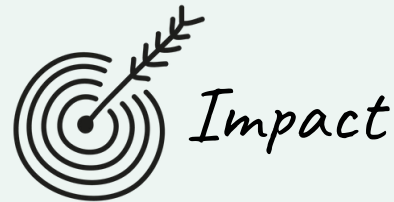

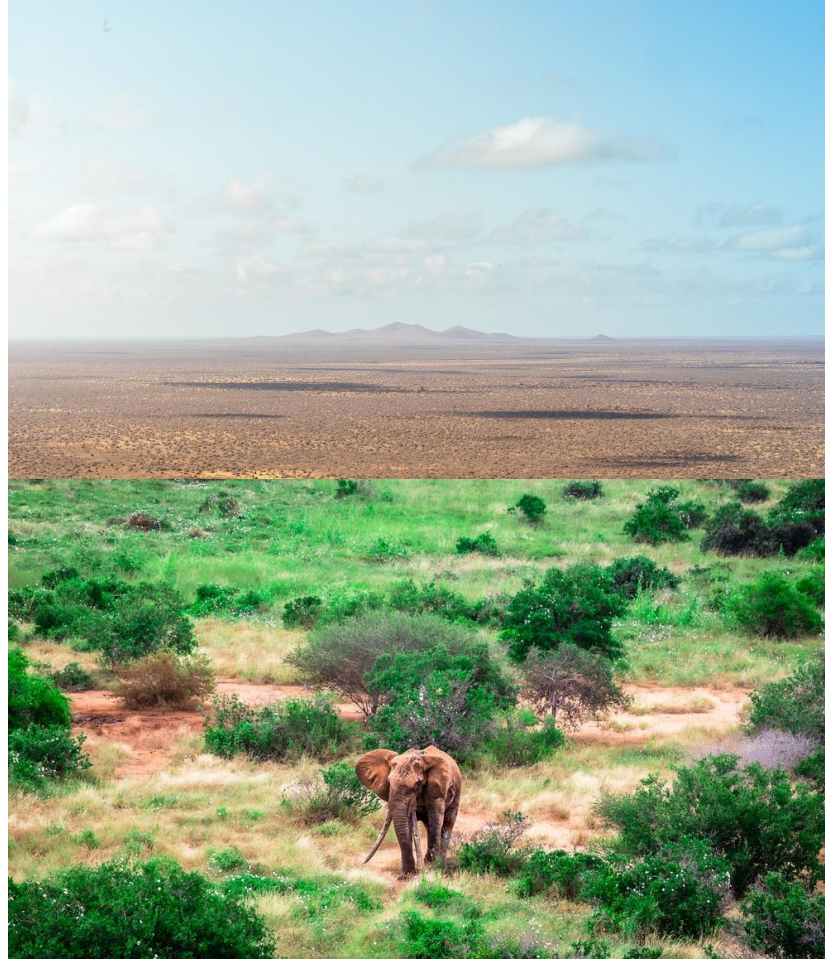

Environmental & Rural Solutions (ERS) promotes landscape restoration for thriving rural livelihoods in the Umzimvubu Catchment of South Africa. Its conservation efforts include protecting water resources, expanding protected areas, and fostering a local conservation economy through innovative solutions such as eco-charcoal from cleared alien invasives and conservation agreements for rotational resting of rangelands to improve productivity and biodiversity.

Fanamby, which means 'embracing challenge' in Malagasy, is one of Madagascar's pioneering conservation organizations. Working across half a dozen protected areas spanning more than 500,000 hectares of Madagascar's diverse forests, they help resident communities responsible for managing these forests to generate income from markets through agricultural products, such as vanilla, and community-based ecotourism ventures.

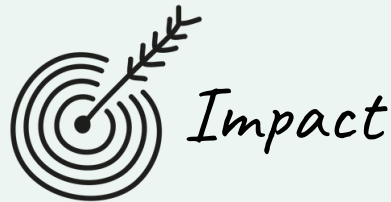

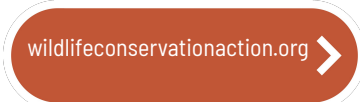

Wildlife Conservation Action (WCA) was founded in 2019, dedicated to fostering coexistence between humans and wildlife in some of Zimbabwe's most critical wildlife areas. By integrating indigenous knowledge and scientific expertise, WCA collaborates closely with local communities, innovating effective solutions for human-wildlife conflict that directly improve livelihoods while protecting wildlife populations, specifically lions and elephants.
